Our packaging experts' suggestions for the valve and clip worked seamlessly with the IBC, ensuring a secure fit. Operators noted the ergonomic design, making it easy to connect the snout to the filling head without requiring additional handling during the filling process. The liners were filled and disconnected from the filling head with zero stress on the bag. During the trial, three lines were successfully filled.

Following this success, CDF and the manufacturer trialed a 1000L Form-Fit in the Tosca 1000L Superior, with a 1" Elpo and DN50 bottom fitment. The Form-Fit Elpo connected perfectly to the filling head, and the liner unfolded seamlessly in the IBC. No handling was needed during the filling process, allowing operators to perform other tasks without needing to monitor the filling.
